Seasons and Weather

Standard 2: Earth and Space Science. Students will gain an understanding of Earth and Space Science through the study of earth materials, celestial movement, and weather.

Science Language: data, foggy, globe, identify, map, models, precipitation, record, season, weather

Objective 3: Compare and contrast seasonal weather changes.

1. Identify characteristics of the seasons of the year.
2. Identify characteristics of weather, e.g., types of precipitation, sunny, windy, foggy, and cloudy.
3. Observe and record weather information within each season.

Big Idea-Seasonal weather changes occur each year.

1. Click on the URL below.
 - a. Each season has the same animals and objects.
 - b. Click on the different objects in the pictures for each season. They do different things for each season.
 - c. As you click on the objects or animals, have the students explain how it relates to each season.
 - d. Write what they do during each season on the board or on chart papers.
 - e. Have the students tell of real experiences they have seen that relate to what is happening in the seasons.
