

Evidences of Weathering and Erosion

Broken sediments at the base of hills and mountains
Small and large holes in rock
Spaces between rock spires joined near the bottom of rock formations
Gaps between rock formations on the ground
Pointed spires
Layers exposed on rock formations
Canyons in the mountains
Overhangs over water and rock
Vertical dug-out crevices on sides of the mountains
Slick, vertical rock
Ground dug out where the part of the ground is lower than other parts
Water levels visible on mountainsides
Fan-looking sediments below crevices and canyons
Cracks in rocks
Gouges in the rocks and mountains
Big scoops of rock gone from the mountains (valleys)
Mountain peaks are thin

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
